**ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE 50TH GRADUATION
CEREMONY ON
FRIDAY 27TH NOVEMBER 2026**

Egerton University wishes to inform ALL candidates who have qualified for the conferment of various degrees and award of diplomas of Egerton University during the 2025/2026 academic year that the 50th Graduation Ceremony will take place on **Friday 27th November 2026** starting at **8.30 a.m.** at Njoro Campus. **ALL GRADUANDS AND GUESTS ARE EXPECTED TO BE SEATED BY 8.00 A.M.**

To ensure a smooth graduation process and enhance accuracy and speed of processing of certificates, the prospective graduands are requested to observe the following and strictly adhere to the specified deadlines.

1. CONFIRMATION OF EXAMINATION RESULTS

It is the responsibility of each prospective graduand to confirm his/her **EXAMINATION RESULTS** by contacting their respective Deans' offices from **Monday 14th September 2026**. The results are also available in the student portal.

2. APPLICATION FOR GRADUATION

All prospective graduands who were admitted since 2015 are required to apply for graduation online through their **student portal** as follows:

- i. Apply for clearance by Finance from the student portal under "**Clearance application**" by **Friday, 9th October 2026**. Postgraduate Graduands will be cleared for graduation by both the Board of Post Graduate Studies and Finance Department.
- ii. Once cleared by Finance, apply for graduation under "**Graduation application**" by **Friday, 23rd October 2026**.

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3. PAYMENT OF GRADUATION AND ALUMNI FEES

The following are the mandatory fees for the various categories of graduands.

Graduands are expected to pay the Graduation Fees before applying for clearance by Finance.

These fees **MUST** be paid through **E-CITIZEN** (Log into the student portal, click on E-payment and follow the instructions)

4. ORDER OF NAMES ON CERTIFICATE

The prospective graduands must ensure that their full names are in the order in which they shall appear in the final certificate and should be the same as in KCSE certificate. **Any correction thereafter shall attract a fee.**

5. ACADEMIC DRESS

During the ceremony, all graduands will be required to be in full academic attire. Graduands are required to download and complete relevant forms and pick the graduation attire from their respective Faculties from **Wednesday, 25th November, 2026**. All hired gowns must be returned by **Monday 14th December 2026**, after which a daily penalty of Kes. 500/= will be charged.

6. REHEARSAL

All graduands who wish to participate in the ceremony and have paid all fees **MUST** attend the rehearsal on **Thursday, 26th November 2026** at **10.00 a.m.** All graduands attending the rehearsal should be seated by **10.30 a.m.** and be in complete academic attire.

7. INVITATION CARD

All prospective graduands are expected to download the invitation card.

8. 50TH GRADUATION INFORMATION

The prospective graduands are encouraged to visit **graduation.egerton.ac.ke** to access more information on the 50th graduation ceremony including downloading the programme, graduation booklet, Newslink magazine and graduation etiquette. The website will be activated

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during the graduation week as from **23rd November 2026**. This website will feature graduation speakers, a section where parents, friends and guardians can share graduation messages and photos, live stream details and responses to frequently asked questions (FAQs).
